  - Compete in up to 5 carnivals held on Sundays prior to 2025 State Titles competitions
  - Compete in the relevant State Titles competition:
    - Juniors (12-14 years) – 5 – 7 July 2025
    - Senior (15 years) – 7 – June 2025
